Every one was asked to email there opposition to the MP, National Grid, South Norfolk county council, Norfolk County Council, Natural England, The Secretary of State, MP Greg Hands, enquiries at beis and anyone else that might be able to help.

The clerk will format a letter to be sent to the councillors which they can comment on and suggest or add to as they think fit. This letter will also be sent to all of the above.

Letters will be hand delivered to every house in Winfarthing urging them to also contact all of the above people to convey there concern and to ask that the cables should be put under the sea.

James Easter reported that South Norfolk Council offices will move to the old Aviva building in Norwich. There may be an office available in Diss for meeting of Council members to meet the public.

Mr Easter is also meeting with National Grid and he will take with him the Parish Councils concerns and those concerns from the earlier meeting.

All house planning has be stopped because of the concerns of Natural England to make environmental contamination neutral.

Deal farm is still be considered by South Norfolk.
